I create one-off sculptural pieces as well as a varied range of dinnerware in porcelain.

My figurative sculptures depict characters from my imaginary circus of curious creatures. My aim is to infuse them with energy and emotion that inspires imagination and begins a story.

My functional tableware is wheel-thrown, carved and altered. Using a lithograph technique, I transfer photographic images, add words and color or glaze in a simple celadon glaze.

I have been a full-time working ceramic artist for 25 years on the British Channel Island of Jersey and now in Kansas City.
