ARTIST STATEMENT:

In a career that has merged from fashion design to making sculptural pieces, many things speak

to me during my design process. My work juxtaposes old-world objects with a contemporary

aesthetic. The tension between the traditional and the modern, the natural world and urban

architectural structures, the organic and the man-made all inspire my design process.

Guided by my interests in contemporary fashion and decorative objects, I experiment in the act

of embellishment, to add decorative detail and to alter the object, changing the meaning and

establishing a new relevance. My mission is to develop a style based on re-appropriating the

forgotten, the swept aside, into the 21st Century.

Using techniques such as wrapping, twisting, knotting, and braiding various types of yarns and

cords to create unique and interesting textures and shapes, I fabricate a second skin to enhance

an object and add a new and heightened sense of energy. Color, texture, and detail are all

integral in my work, to encourage the viewer to consider multiple meanings in each piece. My

intention is to develop a body of work combining avant-garde fashion interacting with three-

dimensional sculptures.
