I have always been interested in the ethereal, either in visual art or music - allowing for escape into a world of beauty from the everyday mundane. Inspired by natural forms, astronomy, and many other things I find beautiful, I have worked for many years to create my own visual language. It is through this language that I aim to ask the viewer insert their own meaning, responding intuitively to the motifs, just as I do. The building of this language on the surface allows me to respond to successes and mistakes until I "see" the completed painting, allowing some sort of visceral experience to tell me when a work is completed.

Body of Work

I continue to leap from hard surfaces, mainly aluminum with resin layers, canvas or paper. Recently, color is applied straight from the tube/ ink bottle (an art school no-no) with very limited neutralization/mixing. There has been a lot of freedom within being able to make that mistake on purpose.

This body of work is the culmination of efforts over the past three years to take time and edit down the use of various processes and motifs. Heavily influenced by love (three devastating losses), and some great success, these works have pulled and guided me in, closer and closer, for an always evolving and growing appreciation of life itself.
